In table II of the paper, the standardised mortality ratios for coronary heart disease for men, using Scotland as a reference standard, should be 78.5 (95% confidence interval 76, 81); 112.3 (100, 125); 106.6 (96, 118); 101.6 (85, 120); 100.6 (77, 128); 66.8 (37,110); 48.7 (28, 78) and 95.2 (89, 102) for UK (other), N Ireland, R Ireland, India, Pakistan, China, Hong Kong and the rest of the world respectively.
